Subject: - Credit hours for CME on "North Zone Conference".

Kindly refer to your letter dated 05.08.2024.

I have been directed by Dr. C. S. Pruthi, President, Punjab Medical Council to convey the decision of the council that the **Ten (10) Credit Hours for CME from 13th to 15th Sept, 2024** be awarded on the basis of CME scientific programme on the following condition (Sr. No. 1 to 12):-

1. The conference/ CME/ Workshop shall be under the auspices of Punjab Medical Council. The banner showing the same may please be displayed at a suitable area.
2. Organizing Secretary must invite personally the representative of PMC being deputed with detailed program and proper arrangement for parking and stay be made.
3. The nominated member of the Punjab Medical Council should be suitably seated on the dais and will address the gathering about the policies of the Punjab Medical Council for a few minutes.
4. The registration of nominated members of the council attending the Conference/ CME/ Workshop will be complimentary.
5. The organizer/ secretary will provide the list of participants before signing of the certificates to PMC observer/ observers, alongwith the Medical Council registration number
6. The organizer may be required to send attendance sheet of all participants to PMC, duly signed by the PMC observer after the completion of conference/ CME.
7. The observer deputed by the PMC will sign the certificate. The registration numbers of attending doctors must be mentioned on the certificates and distributed to the doctors after completion of the Conference/ CME/ Workshop. Digital signature on CME's certificate is not allowed.
8. It is mandatory to print PMC Logo on CME's certificate and mention the Punjab Medical Council Letter No & Date on Certificates.
9. The organizer should ensure that the CME credit hours are being awarded only to the allopathic doctors i.e. MBBS & P.G. and not to the doctors of other allied pathies.
10. The organizer should award CME certificates to the doctors who have physically attended the CME/ Workshop. In case the physical/offline conference will not be possible, in these circumstances, the credit hours granted shall stand cancelled.
11. **It is clarified that:-**
 - a) There shall be no promotion of drug/equipment for particular company.
 - b) Individual marketing by nursing homes/ hospitals/ persons shall not be done.
 - c) Self- promotion/advertisement shall not be done.
12. In case of violation of any term and condition mentioned above (Sr. No. 1 to 11) Punjab Medical Council observer reserved for right to recommend the cancellation of CME hours.
